Job Role

The role is 39 hours. Monday - Friday 7.30am - 4.30pm and duties will include:

- Loading and unloading delivery vehicles, by hand or with a forklift truck.

- Taking goods to the appropriate storage space – perhaps using loading and lifting gear for heavy goods, like washing machines.
- Keeping a careful record of the stock on the warehouse management system, so that it can be located quickly.
- Operating a forklift truck to move and rearrange stock and ensure that products are stored safely and labelled correctly and safely.
- Organising transfers and loading goods on to delivery vehicles.
- Cleaning and maintaining the warehouse will also be part of the daily routine.
- With heavy equipment in operation warehouses can be dangerous places, so following workplace health and safety rules will be essential.
- Quality Control on good inwards and outwards.
- Maintenance of the yards and storage areas.
- Health and safety duties in the factory.

Applicants must have GCSE grades at D/3 or above in English and Maths.

Salary

The successful applicants will ideally be able to start either immediately on a salary of £4.15 per hour with increments based on successful progression.
